

Jacobus Capone is an Australian artist born in 1986. Embraces futility. Pointlessness. Moments gone. Subtleties. What one knows and how one experiences time, ones' ambivalence inside this historical moment, sense of life as a strange mix of stasis, progression and regression - how "art" addresses this feeling. He has recently returned to Perth following a residency in Iceland.

Jason Hendrik Hansma was born in Lahore, Pakistan, in 1988. He has lived in Bangkok, Thailand and Perth, Australia and is currently undertaking a Masters of Arts at the Piet Zwart Institute, Rotterdam. His most recent project involved developing a suite of video and sculptural works concerning a 2000 year old Agave plant in the Amsterdam Botanical Gardens.

Bennett Miller is a sculptor and installation artist from Perth, Western Australia. After spending five years obsessed with mini golf, recreating the Iraqi theatre of war across nine different installations (Golf War, 2003 - 2007), Miller has been working almost exclusively with dachshund dogs. He has toured his Daschund UN to Toronto, Sydney, Melbourne, and Birmingham, and was recently featured in NEW 12 at ACCA, Melbourne.

Alistair Rowe uses light and movement in oblique ways to interact with the reflective and transparent qualities of surface and structure, creating works that often respond directly to site. He has recently presented a solo exhibition at Free Range Gallery and has completed residencies at Perth Institute of Contemporary Arts and Fremantle Art Centre.

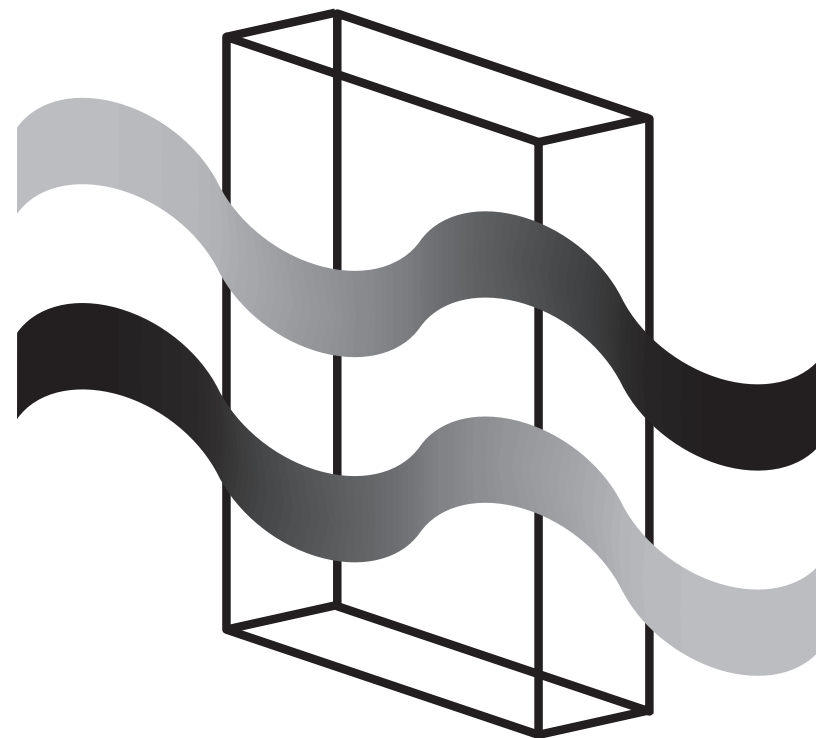
